The committee approved \$500 for the costs of preparing the Pilgrimage Passports and prizes. Copying costs so far (1300 passports) are about \$400; someone in our group has offered to cover up to 1/3 of the cost of the passport program; other donations will be sought with an appeal in the Runestaff and on the Mag Mor list.
