Armor Restrictions: No Lug Shoes. Sharp armor (for example, knee and elbow cops) must be covered or wrapped in cloth.

Directions to 53rd & Huntington

From I-80 heading west: Take Exit 405: North 56th St /US-77 and turn left on 56th
Continue on 56th (heading south) until Cornhusker Hwy (US-6)

Turn right on Cornhusker Hwy (heading west) until 48th St

Turn left on 48th St (heading south) until Huntington St (stop light/Walgreens)

Turn left (east) on to Huntington St until arrive at 53rd and Huntington

From I-80 heading east: Take Exit 399 (Lincoln Airport/ W. Cornhusker Hwy)

Turn left on W . Cornhusker, heading east several miles

Turn right on 48th St, heading south until Huntington St (stop light/Walgreens)

Turn left (east) on to Huntington St until arrive at 53rd St & Huntington

From Highway 2 heading west: Turn right (north) on S 70th Street until Holdrege St

Turn left (west) on Holdrege until 48th St

Turn right (north) on 48th St until Huntington St (stop light/Walgreens)

Turn right (east) on Huntington until arrive at 53rd & Huntington
