

Cattle Raids in Sherwood Forest – August 26 – 28, 2022

Come join the Barony of Mag Mor at a new forested site as we have fun with a Sherwood Forest theme.

Site will open at 6 pm Friday and close at Noon on Sunday

Planned Activities: combat – both armored and cut & thrust, archery, bardic circles, youth quest, lunch inn, Royal Court at Their Royal Majesties' pleasure, and A&S competitions (see Mag Mor [website](#) for A&S competition details).

About the Site: This beautiful, shady site is almost an hour closer to much of Calontir. There are hotels/ motels/restaurants within a few minutes' drive of site. There's no feast, so that's important!



The Lodge (the Commons) is fully air-conditioned and fully accessible (split level entryways AND an elevator) with a large commons area and spacious outdoor balcony and a commercial kitchen -- someday we will feast again! The lower level has three large bunk rooms with restrooms and showers. Up to 50 attendees can choose to bunk inside (and air-conditioned) rather than camp. Indoor masking is no longer required – yippee! Tent campers will have easy access to showers and restrooms via the empty bunk room. Contact the event steward to reserve a bunk – otherwise, first come, first served.

Six sky-camps (elevated, un-airconditioned, screened, platform tents) are also available, with 4 cots each. One is accessible by ramp, the rest by stairs. The sky camp area has its own restrooms, showers, fire ring and picnic tables. Contact the event steward to reserve – otherwise, first come, first served.

Lunch: The Lunch Inn will be in the Lodge and donation based. (See Mag Mor [website](#) for menu).

Merchants: Welcome! Within the Commons, tables are available (can't take 'em outside). Advance Merchant Registration is **REQUIRED by July 15th**

Site Restrictions: NO alcohol, NO smoking, and NO pets.

Additional Cattle Raids Details:

Armored Combat: Our traditional Bring Your Best Tournament and a One-on-One Bridge Tourney (two-handed weapons only). Graf Volkmar will be marshal in charge.

Cut & Thrust Combat: The Sheriff of Nottingham has designed a competition to find the best duelist in the land using a contest with a variety of scenarios that no ordinary ruffian might complete. Tourney entrants will vie to show their best and then escape the consequences of winning such an event. Surely this isn't a trap?

Additional tourneys are also being prepared to sate those who may need more. Authorization and melees will be dependent upon interest and available marshals. The field will open at 9:00 am for inspections and warm-ups. First tournament will start at 10:00 am.

Archery: 9:00 – 11:00 am: Period Bull('s eye) and Wand

1:00 – 3:00 pm: Robin Hood String Shoot (I shoot the arrow, YOU try to split it).

Other shoots as time allows. Lord Yoichi will be archery marshal in charge.

Equestrian: maybe a Hobby Horse tourney?

A&S Competitions: a "Bring Your Best Bycocket" in any medium, "Best Painted Pre-Print Scroll" (entered by either the painter or the recipient) and a "Best Border Blank Scroll" for either the Kingdom or the Barony. All populace choice! Sign in by 10:30 am on Saturday in the Commons, competition closes at 4:00 pm. Lady Morgana McDermott will be coordinating A&S competitions.

Introduction to Calligraphy Class: Taught by Lord Matthais Worcestershire, 1:00 to about 3:00 pm in the air-conditioned Commons. Limited to 12 participants. Materials will be provided. Middle school or older, please!

Youth Activities: There will be tables in the Commons Area with further information and sign-up lists for youth participants, parents, and unofficial helpers who participate in each activity. Ministry of Youth rules will be followed. Lady Adelheid Vromeke will be coordinating youth activities, assisted by Lord Jean Jollivette.

10 and under – activities with parent/guardian:

Explore the Site Treasure Hunt – With a site map in hand, go to designated places and collect a jewel. Return to the Commons Area and create your own medallion by gluing the jewels onto a wooden disk on a cord.

Decorate Your Shield – At a table in the Commons, use crayons and various paste-on items to decorate your very own a 12 inch x 16 inch cardboard shield.

11 and over:

Youth D & D Game Session – run by Lord Ivan Boe Porvinin, with an assistant. Lord Ivan ran Youth D & D at Lilies. Must be 11 or older to participate.

And one or two of the following activities – in pairs or small teams, accompanied by a parent/guardian:

- Rank Rustling – With a list of various SCA ranks and descriptions of items worn, find and greet individuals who represent each rank and ask them sign your list for that rank.
- Heraldry Hunt – With a list of various heraldic elements in hand, find as many at the event as you can. Note where you saw the element (next to a tent, on the list field, etc.)
- Mag Mor Mystery Quest – Using clues and riddles, find the mystery object of the quest. **You will not need to go into un-mowed areas. Beware poison ivy!**

Lunch Inn: Planned menu includes skewered pork, skewered chicken, venison hand pies, falafel, flat bread, 2 kinds of lentils (one with bacon, one vegan), cheese, boiled eggs, cooked and raw carrots, various fruit and baked desserts, water, and sodas. Donation\$ greatly appreciated! Lunch is being coordinated by a team and features recipes from Mistress Gwyneth.

Friends Sharing Food with Friends Table: There will be a table in the Commons Area with coffee & hot water for tea/cocoa. In addition, there will be individually wrapped stuff donated by anyone who wants to donate. There will probably be some breakfast items and snack items.

Bardic Circles: several fire rings and plenty of wood are available for Friday and Saturday evening bardic activities -- story-telling, singing, etc.
